★Event

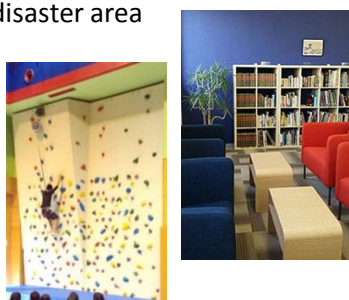
Organize events aimed at enhancing the students’ school experience.
